**AN ACT Relating to Powers of Inland Fish and Game Wardens, as
Coastal Wardens.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 34, § 9, amended. Section 9 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 9. Sheriffs, deputy sheriffs, police officers, constables and inland fish and game wardens to have powers of coastal wardens; wardens not to hold other office. Sheriffs, deputy sheriffs, police officers ~~and~~, constables and inland fish and game wardens are vested with the powers of coastal wardens, and shall receive for similar services the same fees as those of coastal wardens. Coastal wardens appointed under the provisions of section 8 shall hold no other state, county or town office from which they receive compensation.'
