**AN ACT Relating to Compensation for Specified Injuries Under the
Workmen's Compensation Law.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 26, § 13, amended. Section 13 of chapter 26 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding before the last paragraph thereof the following:

'For the loss of hearing in one ear, 42 weeks.

For the loss of hearing in both ears, 175 weeks.

For permanent and serious disfigurement of the head and face, 25 weeks.'
