RESOLVE, in Favor of Monmouth Academy.

Monmouth academy; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$15,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the state to be expended by the joint school committee of Monmouth academy toward the building and equipping of a gymnasium building for use in furnishing secondary school privileges to the youth of Monmouth and the general vicinity. Notwithstanding the provision for an appropriation of \$15,000 said appropriation shall not exceed 25% of the total cost of the gymnasium building and equipment. Any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This appropriation would be used toward the building of a new gymnasium and equipping same for use of Monmouth academy and general vicinity.
