STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Annuities for Dependents of Members of Police and Fire Departments of the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1927, c. 75, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 75 of the private and special laws of 1927 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 3. Widows, children and dependents, provisions for. The city of Portland is further authorized to provide, by ordinance, for the payment to the widow of any member of its police or fire department, who has lost his life in the performance of his duty, an annuity of not more than twenty-five dollars \$50 per month, so long as she remains a widow and in need of such annuity. If a policeman or fireman who has lost his life in the performance of his duty leaves no widow, such annuity may be paid to the minor children or other persons dependent upon such member of the police or fire department, for such period as the city council may determine.'
