## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Department of Electrical Appliances of the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1917, c. 161, § 4, amended. Section 4 of chapter 161 of the private and special laws of 1917 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'The city of Portland is further authorized to provide, by ordinance, for the payment to the widow of any member of its department of electrical appliances who has lost his life in the performance of his duty, a monthly annuity of not more than  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the final monthly base pay of such member so long as she remains a widow and in need of such annuity. If a member of the department of electrical appliances who has lost his life in the performance of his duty leaves no widow, such annuity may be paid to the minor children or other persons dependent upon such member of the department of electrical appliances, for such period as the city council may determine.'
