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**RESOLVE to Reimburse the City of Bangor for Fire Fighting Service.**

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**City of Bangor; reimbursed. Resolved:** That the sum of \$8,223.40 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the city of Bangor to compensate said city of Bangor for sending fire apparatus and members of the Bangor fire department to assist in fighting the fire during the month of October, 1947 in the town of Mount Desert and the town of Bar Harbor; said amount to be paid from the general fund.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

In October 1947, a serious conflagration threatened the destruction of buildings and property in the town of Mount Desert and the town of Bar Harbor, and a request for assistance was made to the city of Bangor to supply fire fighting apparatus and men in an effort to stop the spread of the fire then in progress, and commencing October 21, through October 24, 1947, the Bangor fire department in response to said request, responded with a crew of men and fire fighting equipment and remained on the job through the entire period commencing October 21, and ending October 24, 1947, in the case of Bar Harbor and commencing October 24, and ending October 27, 1947 in the case of Mount Desert.
