**AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Deputy Register of Deeds and Clerks in
the Office of Register of Deeds, in the County of Cumberland.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 212 of the public laws of 1945 and by chapter 259 of the public laws of 1947, which relates to the salaries of the deputy register of deeds and clerks in the office of register of deeds, in Cumberland county, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

for clerks in the office of register of deeds, ~~\$10,300~~ **\$15,500**; with the additional sum of ~~\$1,000~~ **\$4,500**, which additional sum shall be available for the period of 2 years from the effective date hereof; ~~deputy register of deeds, \$2,200~~
