AN ACT Relating to Applications for Liquor Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 24, amended. The 1st sentence of section 24 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'All applicants for license shall be required to file applications in such form as the commission shall require, and every application shall disclose the complete and entire ownership in the establishment for which a license is sought **and if applicant is a purchaser by contract, in addition, the terms of said contract.**'
