AN ACT Regulating Sale of Malt and Malt Syrup.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 61, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 61 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Malt or malt syrup shall not be sold except for bakery or industrial purposes by any person, or sold as a beverage except as malt beverages already provided for by law or any form of malt beverage which contains 1% or less of alcohol in content by volume.'
