## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Relating to the Revocation of Liquor Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec I. R. S., c. 57, § 60, sub § II, amended. Subsection II of section 60 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended by section I of chapter 163 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following new paragraphs:

'J. Conviction of violation of any law of this state or of the United States relating to the manufacture, possession, transportation or sale of intoxicating liquor, except sales to minors;

K. Conviction of violation of any law of the United States relating, to carrying on the business of a wholesale or retail dealer without a federal tax stamp;

L. Conviction of the violation of the provisions of section 32 of the United States liquor taxing act of 1934 relating to having in possession distilled spirits in unstamped containers;

M. Transferring, assigning or hypothecating a license.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 57, § 60 sub § III, repealed. Subsection III of section 60 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended by sections 2 and 3 of chapter 163 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby repealed.
