RESOLVE Regulating Fishing in Certain Ponds in Somerset County.

Certain ponds in Somerset county; fishing regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening to fly fishing only the following ponds in Somerset county:

Little Fish pond, in Alder Brook township;

Hall pond, in Prentiss township; and

Marie Petush, in Prentiss township, an inlet of Hall pond.
