IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Telephones for Members of the State Police.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13, § 3-A, additional. Chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 3-A, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 3-A. Telephones. Members of the state police shall be provided at the expense of the state with telephone service at their respective places of residence.’
