RESOLVE to Repeal State Pension for Fred Jacques of Van Buren.

Fred Jacques; state pension repealed. Resolved: That part of chapter 154 of the resolves of 1947, which provides for a state pension for Fred Jacques of Van Buren, is hereby repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1947, Mr. Jacques received a state pension of \$20 per month. He has now been committed to the state hospital.
