STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE to Repeal State Pension for Joseph Duperry of Fairfield.

Joseph Duperry; state pension repealed. Resolved: That part of chapter 154 of the resolves of 1947, which provides for a state pension for Joseph Duperry of Van Buren, is hereby repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Duperry received a state pension of \$20 per month in 1947. He has now been committed to the state hospital.
