RESOLVE in Favor of the Town of Freeman.

Town of Freeman; appropriation for. Resolved: That the money appropriated in favor of the town of Chesterville by the 93rd legislature for the fiscal year 1948-49 for resurfacing and construction of the Foster Hill road, be, and hereby is, reappropriated in favor of the town of Freeman to be expended for the fiscal year 1949-50 for resurfacing and construction of the Foster Hill road; said sum to be taken from the general highway fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Through error the appropriation which was intended for the Foster Hill road in the town of Freeman by the 93rd legislature was designated for the town of Chesterville. This resolve is intended to correct the error.
