AN ACT Relating to Powers and Duties of Liquor Inspectors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 6, sub-§ XV, amended. Subsection XV of section 6 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 88 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'XV. To appoint, subject to the provisions of the personnel law, a chief inspector and as many inspectors as may from time to time be found necessary. **Their powers and duties shall include the duty to inquire into and arrest for violations of any of the provisions of this chapter, and to arrest for impersonation of or interference with liquor inspectors.'**
