AN ACT Relating to Superintending School Committees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 50-B, additional. Chapter 37 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 50-B, to read as follows:

'Sec. 50-B. Decisions of school committees, limitation. A teacher shall be removed by the superintending school committee within 30 days of filing a petition if signed by 51% of the parents or guardians of the pupils being taught by said teacher.'
