STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Jurisdiction of Divorce Actions by Justice of Superior Court in Vacation.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 153, § 55, amended. The last sentence of section 55 of chapter 153 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The superior court, or any justice thereof in vacation, has jurisdiction of libels for divorce in all counties.'
