STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Weir Fishing in Certain Waters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 34, § 46-A, additional. Chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 46-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 46-A. Weir fishing in certain waters. It shall be unlawful to fish by weir within the following described waters: Beginning at Pemaquid Point in the town of Bristol, Lincoln county, and following the shore running in a westerly direction to Portland Head, in Casco Bay, Cumberland county, including all bays, coves and tributaries.

The provisions of this section shall not apply to weirs already constructed or to persons who have already obtained a permit to construct a weir within the above-described waters.'
