STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Wholesale Sale of Spirituous and Vinous Liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 57, § 41, repealed and replaced. Section 41 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
- 'Sec. 41. Liquor to be bought from commission. All persons, except public service corporations operating interstate, licensed to sell spirituous or vinous liquor shall purchase all such liquor from the commission. The commission shall sell to such licensees spirituous and vinous liquor for a price of 10% less than the retail price in state retail stores provided that such discount shall not apply to federal taxes levied on and after April 1, 1941.'
