AN ACT Relating to Labels on Bottles of Liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, § 220-A, additional. Chapter 27 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 220-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 220-A. Labels on bottles of liquor. All bottles containing liquor shall have thereon a label which shall state the quantitative and qualitative analysis of the contents.'
