STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE in Favor of Higgins Classical Institute.

Higgins Classical Institute; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$50,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the state to be expended by the president and the board of trustees of Higgins Classical Institute toward the renovating and construction of dormitory building, and enlarging and equipping recreational facilities adequate for the growth of the school. Notwithstanding the provision for an appropriation of \$50,000, said appropriation shall not exceed 25% of the total cost of the dormitory building and equipment.

Any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Higgins Classical Institute draws pupils from some 60 Maine towns and the closing of small high schools has thrown an additional responsibility upon the medium priced preparatory schools. Higgins will serve as an area school in the immediate vicinity of Charleston.
