RESOLVE in Favor of Robert Traip Academy.

Robert Traip academy; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Robert Traip academy, the sum of \$1500 from July 1, 1949 to June 30, 1950, and the sum of \$1500 from July 1, 1950 to June 30, 1951, said sums to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of said academy. Said amounts are to be taken from the adjustment fund as provided by subsection II of section 106 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes.
