**RESOLVE, Providing for a Fish Screen at Outlet of Lower Hot Brook
in the Town of Danforth.**

Outlet of Lower Hot Brook; screening of. Resolved: That the sum of \$750 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game for installing a fish screen at outlet of Lower Hot Brook in the town of Danforth, in the counties of Aroostook and Washington; provided that the Danforth Rod and Gun Club shall assume all liability for keeping of said screen free from all sticks, leaves and debris so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

That portion of Lower Hot Brook lake which is to be screened is in Aroostook county. The Danforth Rod and Gun Club wish to introduce game fish into Upper Hot Brook and Lower Hot Brook lake.
