RESOLVE Appropriating Money to Set Buoys in Inland Waters.

Setting of buoys in inland waters; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$1,200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950 and the sum of \$600 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1951, to be expended under the direction of the public utilities commission for the purpose of setting buoys in inland waters.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It is desired to aid navigation by marking dangerous ledges and rocks in the inland waters of the state.
