STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Certain Data in Possession of State Tax Assessor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14, § 62-A, additional. Chapter 14 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, to be numbered 62-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 62-A. Data of state tax assessor made available. Data possessed by the state tax assessor relating to any matter which he has the authority to investigate or determine and pertinent to or of assistance in the duties of tax assessment shall upon request by municipal tax assessors be made available to them by the state tax assessor under such reasonable conditions and circumstances as he may prescribe.'
