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**AN ACT** Relating to Automatic Signals at Railroad Crossings.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 42, § 88, amended.** The 2nd sentence of section 88 of chapter 42 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

‘; except that at crossings located on state and state aid highways the expense of installing such signal, gates or other protection device shall be apportioned between such corporation and the state in such proportions as said commission shall determine.’
