COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1799, L. D. 1141, Bill, "An Act
Relating to the Taking of Clams, Quahogs,
Mussels and Worms in the Town of Islesboro"

Amend said Bill by striking out, at the end of the 1st sentence,
the words "or a person who is assessed and pays a real estate tax
therein"

Further amend said Bill by striking out the words "or taxpayer"
in the 6th line thereof.

Further amend said Bill by inserting before the period at the
end of the 1st paragraph thereof the following words:

'nor any person from digging not in excess of 1/2 bushel in any 1
day for his own use nor any riparian owner from digging on his own
property'
