STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Field Trials for Beagles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 76-A, additional. Chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 76-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 76-A. Field trials for beagle clubs, permitted. It shall be lawful for duly organized beagle clubs to hold field trials between September 1st and April 10th, both days inclusive, annually. During the field trials permitted in this section, no person shall use any firearm other than a pistol loaded with blank ammunition.'
