**RESOLVE, Providing for a Fish Screen in Molunkus Lake.**

---

**Molunkus lake; screening of. Resolved:** That the sum of \$400 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game, for installing a fish screen in Molunkus lake, Aroostook county; provided, however, that the Molunkus Rod and Gun Club shall assume all liability for keeping of said screen free from all sticks, leaves and debris so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Four sporting camp owners near the lake have started the project of building this screen and \$432 has already been spent. It is estimated that it will cost approximately \$400 to finish the job, for which this resolve asks.
