COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1825, L. D. 1151, "Resolve Opening
Lone Pond, in the Town of Waterboro, York
County, to Fishing."

Amend said Resolve by striking out the title and inserting in
place thereof the following new title:

'Resolve Changing the Opening Date for Fishing in Lone Pond,
in the Town of Waterboro, York County.'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out all of said Resolve
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Lone pond; opening date for fishing changed.'

Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game
be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regu-
lation establishing May 1st as the opening date for fishing in Lone
pond, in the town of Waterboro, York county.'
