**RESOLVE** Opening Deer Pond, in the Town of Hollis, York County,  
to Fishing.

---

**Deer pond; opened to fishing. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Deer pond, in the town of Hollis, York county, to fishing, on May 1st, with a daily bag limit of 5 trout per person per day.
