STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Permitting Adoption of Person in County Where Person Lives.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 145, § 35, amended. The 1st sentence of section 35 of chapter 145 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 68 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

Any unmarried inhabitant of the state, or any husband and wife jointly, may petition the judge of probate for their county or the judge of probate for the county where the person lives for leave to adopt a person, regardless of age, and for a change of his or her name.'
