# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Register of Probate and Clerk Hire in Office of Register of Probate in Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of the clerks in the office of register of probate of Androscoggin county, as amended by chapter 316 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$1,820 \$2,120;'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 140, § 22, amended. That part of section 22 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the register of probate of Androscoggin county, as amended by chapter 326 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Androscoggin, \$2,300 \$3,000,'
