### RESOLVE, in Favor of the County of Franklin.

**County of Franklin; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the county of Franklin, the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950, to aid in the construction of the bridge across Carrabasset river at Salem, under the Bridge Act, which said bridge is located on the Howard road, so called.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Much lumbering is carried on in this locality and trucks heavily loaded with lumber must cross this bridge which is practically unsafe.
