IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE Authorizing State of Maine to Purchase Armory at Lewiston.

State of Maine to purchase Lewiston armory. Resolved: That the state of Maine be, and hereby is, directed and authorized to purchase from the city of Lewiston the armory located in that city; and be it further

Resolved: That the sum of \$500,000 be appropriated from the general fund to carry out the purpose of this resolve.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It is important that the state have a building in Lewiston which is owned and controlled by the state for the national guard and other units of military defense.
