IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE Appropriating Moneys to Build Armory in Lewiston.

Armory in Lewiston; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$400,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund to construct and equip an armory in Lewiston under the control and supervision of the Maine defense commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The state owns no armory in Lewiston and because of world conditions it is necessary that the state have facilities available to train manpower.
