RESOLVE in Favor of Healy Asylum of Lewiston.

Healy asylum; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$9,656.43 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Healy asylum, of Lewiston, to reimburse said asylum for board and care of children at said asylum; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The amount of \$9,656.43 is for board and care of children at the Healy asylum. The cases are from separated marriages, sick mothers unable to take care of their children; also from negligent parents and homes where the children have bad examples. Said amount includes care from 1944 to 1948 only.
