## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

#### RESOLVE, in Favor of Procuring Testimonials for the Purpose of Marking the Unmarked Graves of the Soldiers of the Revolutionary War.

Marking of graves of soldiers of the Revolutionary War; appropriation. Resolved: That the sum of \$200 be, and hereby is, appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950, for the purpose of procuring testimonials to be used in marking the unmarked graves of the soldiers of the Revolutionary War; and be it further

**Resolved:** With the approval of the governor and council, said sum shall be paid into the treasurer of the "Sons of the American Revolution", with which they are hereby authorized to procure and distribute such number of markers as may, from time to time, be required for the purposes herein specified.

# STATEMENT OF FACTS

There are numerable unmarked graves of soldiers of the Revolutionary War. These graves should be marked.
