AN ACT Relating to the Penobscot Log Driving Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Additional powers for Penobscot Log Driving Company. Penobscot Log Driving Company in addition to the rights it now has, is further empowered to store water for manufacturing and power purposes on its dam at the outlet of Millinocket Lake in the county of Penobscot, to the present effective height of said dam. Provided however that it shall discharge sufficient water for log driving purposes, and sufficient water at all times for carrying the discharges from sanitary sewers emptying into Millinocket Stream.

In order to make more effective use for manufacturing purposes of water stored in said Millinocket Lake, Penobscot Log Driving Company is hereby authorized by means of suitable mechanical devices to pump, or cause to be pumped and diverted, water from Millinocket Lake into Ambajejus Lake.
