AN ACT Increasing Pensions of Retired Members of the State Police.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Pensions increased. The retired members of the state police shall receive, in addition to their present retirement pay, such additional amounts that will equal $\frac{1}{2}$ of the pay per year that is now or hereafter paid to a member of their respective grades at the time of retirement.

Such moneys shall be appropriated from funds of the state police.
