STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge of the South Portland Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1895, c. 242, § 23, Item VIII, amended. The 1st sentence of Item VIII of section 23 of chapter 242 of the private and special laws of 1895, as amended by chapter 34 of the private and special laws of 1943, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The judge of said court shall receive a salary of \$1,500 \$2,000 per year from the 1st day of January, 1943 1949, to be paid him in quarterly payments from the county treasury of Cumberland county which shall be in full for the services as such judge.'
