STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Repealing Portions of the Bang's Disease Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, §§ 73-75, Repealed. Section 73, as amended by section 2 of chapter 275 of the public laws of 1945; section 74; and section 75, as amended by section 3 of chapter 275 of the public laws of 1945, all of chapter 27 of the revised statutes, are hereby repealed.
