STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey Certain Land to Eunice Winslow of Rockland.

State tax assessor authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the state tax assessor be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Eunice Winslow of Rockland a triangular piece of land, located in Little Deer Isle, which land was part of a larger portion of land purchased by the state for an approach to the Deer Isle-Sedgwick bridge.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This land was purchased from Jeremiah Eaton but was unused after original plans for the state road on Little Deer Isle were changed.
