STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Filing of Accounts in Estates Upon Petition of Sureties on Bonds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 141, § 21, amended. Section 21 of chapter 141 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following paragraph to read as follows:

'Any surety on a probate bond may cite his principal to file an account where such accounting is one of the conditions of said bond and the judge of probate deems such accounting to be appropriate and necessary in the course of administration. But such citation shall issue as a matter of course upon the petition of any party in interest, including such surety, if no accounting has been filed within 3 years from the date of the qualification of the personal representative, or if 3 years have elapsed since the last accounting was approved.'
