COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A: to H. P. 1990, L. D. 1372, Bill, "An Act Relating to Quantity in Purchasing Herring."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the underlined 2nd paragraph of that part designated "Sec. 36" and inserting in place thereof, the following underlined paragraph:

'All holds of all boats transporting herring for processing purposes shall be measured and sealed by the state sealer of weights and measures, or his duly authorized agent, and the fees for measuring and sealing shall be paid by the owners of the boats. The measure shall be in 5 hogshead divisions, cut 3/8 of an inch deep in the hold of the boat. The state sealer of weights and measures shall forthwith certify to the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries the name of the owner of each boat, the name of each boat and the capacity of each boat.'
