## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Establishing Infirmaries at the State Hospitals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 23, § 103-A, additional. Chapter 23 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 103-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 103-A. Commission for survey. The governor, with the advice and consent of the council, shall appoint 5 persons to constitute a commission for the purpose of determining the advisability of establishing infirmaries at the state hospitals or a home for the aged and infirm anywhere in the state. Such commission shall receive no salary but shall be reimbursed for any expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. A report of the commission shall be made to the 95th legislature.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$5,000 from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund to carry out the purpose of this act.
