IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT to Construct a Bridge Between Old Town and Indian Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Bridge constructed. A single lane bridge shall be constructed between Old Town and Indian Island under the direction of the state highway commission.

Sec. 2. Funds. There is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$165,000 for the construction of such bridge.

Sec. 3. Carrying account. The appropriation shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purpose of this act has been accomplished.
