IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Powers and Duties of Liquor Inspectors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 6, sub-§ XV, amended. The 2nd paragraph of subsection XV of section 6 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'The inspectors shall be under the direct supervision and control of the chief inspector. They shall have the same powers and duties throughout the several counties of the state as sheriffs have in their respective counties relating to liquor. Their powers and duties shall include the duty to inquire into and arrest for violations of any of the provisions of this chapter, and to arrest for impersonation of or interference with liquor inspectors.'
