**RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in Retirement Pension for Harry H. Watson of Prospect.**

---

**Increase in retirement pension for Harry H. Watson. Resolved:** That Harry H. Watson, of Prospect, be given credit for 9 years of teaching service at the Good Will Home Association so that he may be entitled to further retirement benefits under the provisions of chapter 60 of the revised statutes.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Watson, of Prospect is at the present time receiving a pension of \$19.55 for approximately 16 years credits. He taught 9 years (1928-1937) at the Good Will Home Association for which he has never received credit.
